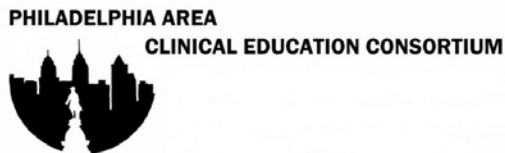


# APTA Credentialed Clinical Instructor Program
